

TIPS FOR VOTING AUGUST 4

Help! I'm not registered!

You may register to vote up to the day of Election Day. If you've never registered in Michigan before, provide a document showing proof of residency **in person** to your city or township clerk's office before 8 pm on Election Day. The document must include your current address and can be in electronic form.

Approved documentation:

- a Michigan driver's license or state ID
- a current utility bill
- a bank statement
- a paycheck
- a government check
- another government document

Absentee ballots must be received by 8pm Election Day!

Track your ballot at BallotPower.org

Need to "spoil" an absent voter ballot?

An absentee ballot may be spoiled in person at the clerk's office until **4 PM THE MONDAY PRIOR TO THE ELECTION**

Where is my clerk's office?

Go to BallotPower.org or the Michigan Secretary of State's website to locate your clerk's office.

Worried your absent voter ballot may not reach the clerk's office by Election Day? Drop it off!

Since Election Day is only a few days away, it's a better to drop off your ballot rather than mail it. Find your clerk's office by going to Ballotpower.org or the Michigan Secretary of State's website. The full list of ballot drop locations can be found linked on our website.
